6 Lights check for damage, cleanliness, correct alignment					
7 Guards check that they are securely fitted					
8 Windscreen wipers/ washers check for wear, damage, fluid level					
9 Engine coolant & oil check fluid levels					
10 Radiator check for leaks, clear of debris					
11 Hydraulic oil cooler check for leaks, clear of debris					
12 Hydraulic oil tank check for damage, leaks, fluid levels					
13 Fuel tank check for damage, leak, fuel level?					
14 Fire extinguisher check for damage/ inspection in-date					
15 Spill Kit check its available and undamaged					
16 Mirrors check for damage, correct adjustment					
17 Hoses check for cracks, leaks and general wear					
18 Belts check for wear, cracks, correct tension					
19 Battery check that its clean and secure, good connections					
20 Engine compartment check for debris, dirt and leaks					
21 Controls check that they are identified and operating correctly					
22 Seat & seat belt check adjustment and that they are being worn					
23 Horn, reversing alarm, beacon Check they are audible and visible					
24 Cab interior check cleanliness, including all touchpoints					
25 Tyres/ tracks good condition correct pressures
